As the situation continues to unfold in Ukraine, we’ve seen a significant uptick in giving among private foundations.

Here’s a look at the key takeaways and giving trends that have emerged in the past 5 weeks since the conflict began on February 24 as our clients make grants to help provide critical care and assistance.



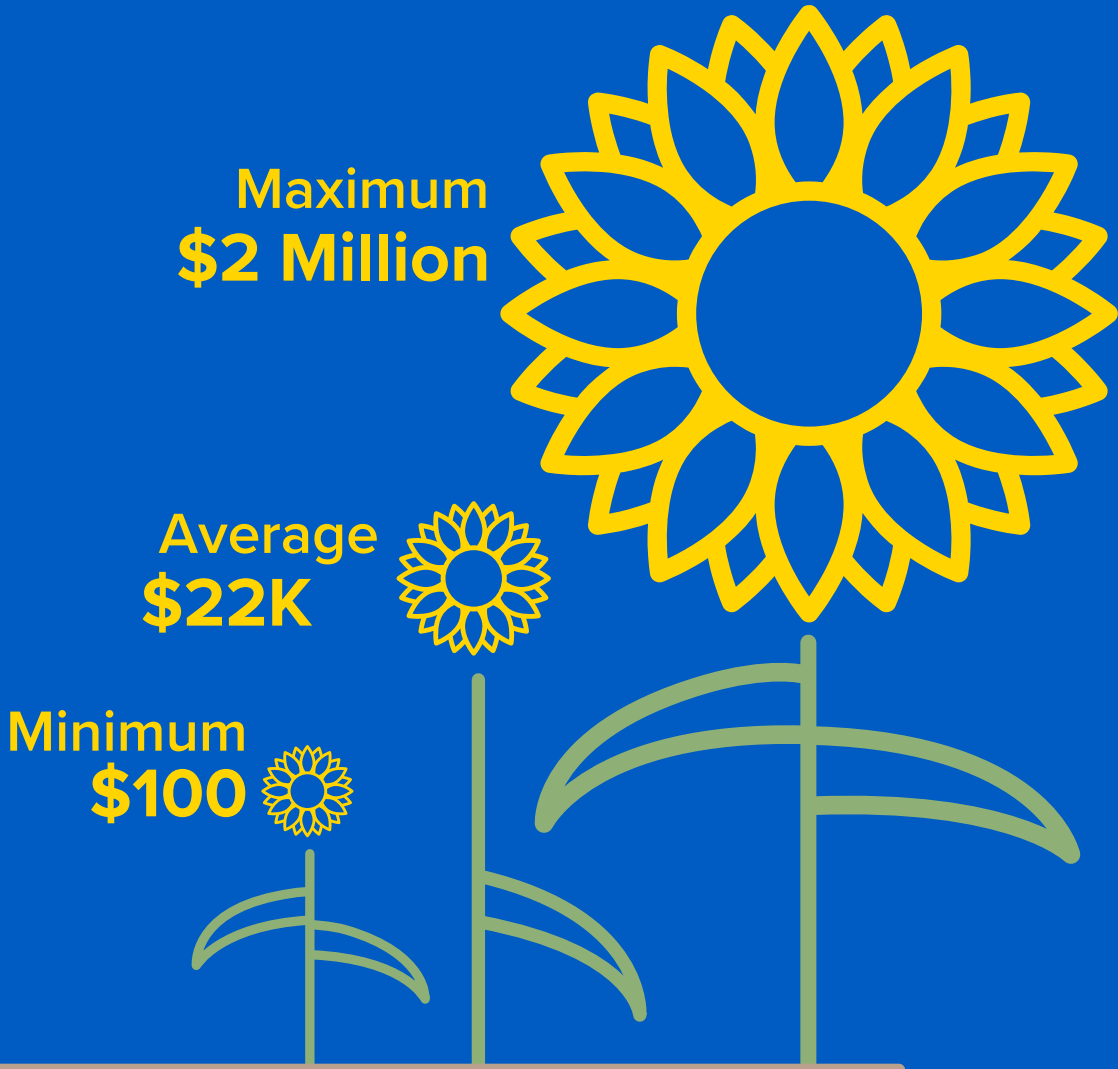
## A Sharp Increase in Giving\*

Grants for Ukraine have already topped

**7.3 Million** in 2022.

The number of grants for Ukraine-specific giving are also on the rise. Prior to 2022, the largest number of grants in a single year was 5 and the average total granted in a single year was \$16,805.
